## DSIB Inspection Report 2023 -24

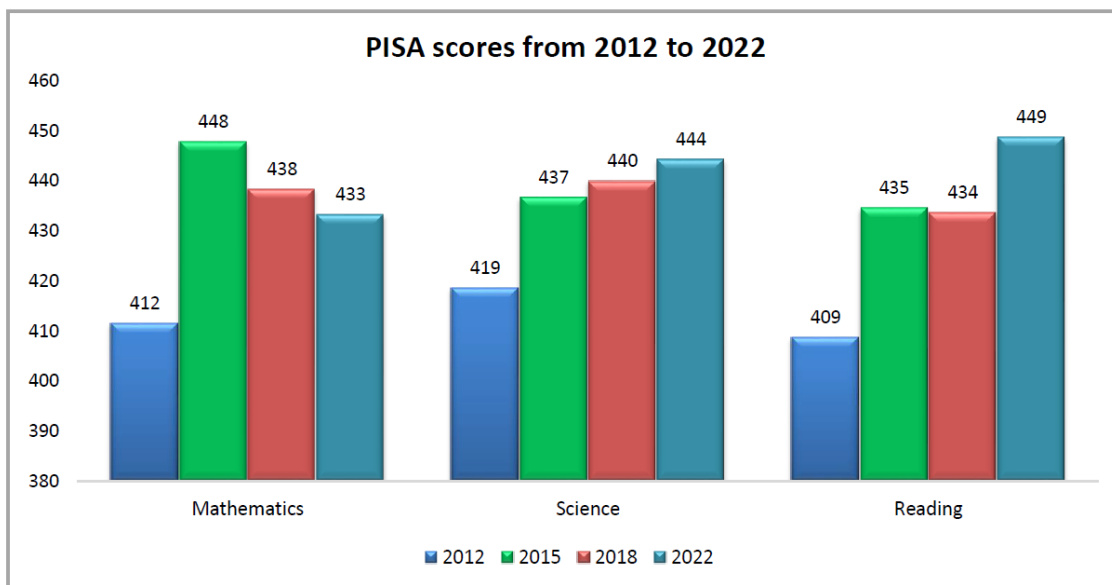
